2 Minutes of Meeting 15.05.2018

RESOLVED: that the Minutes be approved.

3 Choice of contractor to supply Play Area equipment

The Councillors viewed the quotes of 5 different contractors.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk confirm the quote of Caledonia Play, with a view to instructing them to supply the equipment.

4 Amendment to specification

There was a discussion among the councillors about the need for extra work which had become apparent. There were two new quotes for extra paving near the village hall.

RESOLVED: that the specification be amended for the removal of the dangerous hump near the entrance to the Play Area; that the specification be amended for the extra paving, and that Keith Brown be selected for this; that the clerk negotiate prices with contractors for removal of the hump.

5 Parking near Whorlton Hall

The clerk reported the outcome of negotiations with Durham County Council and the manager of Whorlton Hall.

RESOLVED: that Councillors Powell and Wilkinson survey the exact problem areas, and recommend a stretch of road for special road markings, which the clerk will convey to Durham County Council.

RESOLVED: that the Parish Council adopt the draft.
